

**What are the Community Response Services/Help Hubs in each locality/borough council area?**

The Government has asked all local community resilience/resilience hubs to put in place arrangements to respond to requests for help from the most clinically vulnerable people. Arrangements are being put in place through these so that those who need to can access support in the form of directly delivered food parcels and other support needs.

The councils are working in partnership with residents, community groups, businesses, partners and the voluntary sector to provide help and support with everyday needs such as obtaining food parcels, shopping and collecting prescriptions, housing, financial and debt advice, and preventing loneliness.
