- The patient has a faecal management system in place
- The patient should have a faecal management system but is unable to have or tolerate one
- The patient has frequent episodes of liquid faeces/diarrhoea



Use outside pre-authorised areas **must be approved by Tissue Viability** or other appropriate specialist

Other areas of use include the following that have not responded to the products in the skin barrier guidance sheet after 6 weeks.

- skin damage around a fistula
- skin damage around a wound
- skin damage around a gastrostomy (or other peri-tube) site
- skin damage around a stoma
- moisture lesions/incontinence associated dermatitis
- Intertriginous dermatitis (in skin fold)
