BLACK Traffic Light - not recommended for prescribing in primary or secondary care

 Liothyronine 20mcg tablets - not recommended as add on treatment for refractory hypothyroidism, despite adequate monotherapy with levothyroxine

RED Traffic Light - primary care prescribers should not be asked to prescribe

- Fosfomycin IV multi resistant infections where other agents not suitable -approval by consultant microbiologist
- Liothyronine recommended in secondary and tertiary care for specialist indications as per recommendations.
- Cabazitaxel (Jevtana®) -hormonerelapsed metastatic prostate cancer treated with docetaxel - <u>NICE TA391</u>

AMBER Traffic Light - initiated by specialists but may then be passed to primary care for prescribing

- Insulin Degludec adults. cost effective option for patients with difficult to control diabetes initiation by diabetes specialists
- Buprenorphine patch (Butec®)
 to be included in formulary
- Sodium chloride 7% nebules
 (Resp-Ease®) to replace
 Nebusal®) on formulary
- Insulin Degludec Paediatrics cost effective option in difficult to manage diabetes in adolescents - initiation by diabetes specialists
- Ropinirole XL (RequipXL®, Ropilynz XL®) - Ropilynz added to formulary.
- Donepezil. galantamine, rivastigmine - options for mild as well as moderate alzeihmers disease. NICE TA217 (updated)
- Ulipristal actetae (Esmya®) treatment of moderate to severe symptoms of uterine fibroids in adult women of reproductive age.
- Levodopa/Caridopa/Entacapone (Stalevo®, Stanek®) - Stanek® added to formulary
- Memantine option for moderate disease in those who cannot take AChE inhibitors & option for severe disease - NICE TA217 (updated)

GREEN Traffic Light - may be prescribed by all prescribers within local or national recommendations

 Canagliflozin, Dapagliflozin and Empagliflozin monotherapy for Type 2 Diabetes
 NICE TA390
