### BLACK traffic Light - not recommended for prescribing in primary or secondary care.

- **Regorafenib** – previously treated advanced hepatocellular carcinoma – [NICE TA514](#)
- **Trelegy Ellipta**<sup>®</sup> - not recommended for use within ELHE Guidelines
- **Eribulin** - locally advanced or metastatic breast cancer after one chemotherapy regimen. [NICE TA515](#)

### RED traffic light - Primary care prescribers should not be asked to prescribe (\*\* denotes NHS England Commissioned)

- **Autologous chondrocyte implantation using chondrosphere**\*\* – symptomatic articular cartilage defects of the knee [NICE TA508](#)
- **Obinutuzumab**\*\* – untreated advanced follicular lymphoma [NICE TA513](#)
- **Otocomb**<sup>®</sup> ointment – otitis externa for use by ENT only. (unlicensed use)
- **Pertuzumab**\*\* with trastuzumab & docetaxel – HER2-positive breast cancer – [NICE TA509](#) (Cancer Drugs Fund)
- **Brodalumab** - moderate to severe plaque psoriasis - [NICE TA511](#) (CCG Commissioned, Blueteq form required)
- **Cilodex**<sup>®</sup> ear drops – otitis externa and otitis media when tympanostomy in situ. ENT use only.
- **Daratumumab monotherapy**\*\* – relapsed & refractory multiple myeloma [NICE TA510](#) (Cancer Drugs Fund)
- **Tivozanib**\*\* – advanced renal cell carcinoma [NICE TA512](#)
- **Cabozantinib**\*\* – medullary thyroid cancer [NICE TA516](#) (Cancer Drugs Fund)
- **Mydrisert**<sup>®</sup> - pre-operative mydriasis for diagnostic use – ophthalmology use only

### AMBER Traffic Light - initiated by specialists but may then be passed to primary care for prescribing

- **Linezolid** – Traffic light changed from RED to AMBER to allow for longer term treatment. Use on microbiologist advice only.

### GREEN Traffic Light - may be prescribed by all prescribers within local or national recommendations

- **Thick and Easy Clear** – approved as first line thickener in ELHE.
- **Doxycycline dispersible tablets** – for use in patients with swallowing difficulties when doxycycline is the recommended antibiotic
