## Summary

- Dalacin ${ }^{\circledR}$ (clindamycin) $2 \%$ vaginal cream is out of stock until w/c $6^{\text {th }}$ September 2021.
- Alternative topical preparations are available (see Supporting Information below).


## Actions Required

Clinicians prescribing treatment should:

- not initiate any new patients on Dalacin ${ }^{\circledR} 2 \%$ vaginal cream and
- consider prescribing one of the following options:
- Zidoval ${ }^{\circledR}$ (metronidazole) $0.75 \%$ w/w vaginal gel (see Supporting Information below) or
- Fluomizin ${ }^{\circledR}$ (dequalinium chloride) 10 mg vaginal tablets (see Supporting Information below).
- Liaise with local Pharmacy teams to understand local stock availability of alternate products

| Alternative product | Directions for bacterial vaginosis | Stock Availability |

| Zidoval <br> $0.75 \%$ (metronidazole) <br> 0.7 <br> vaginal gel | one application [5g] inserted into the vagina <br> once daily, at bedtime, for 5 consecutive days. | Can support a full uplift in demand. |
| Fluomizin <br> (hloride) 10 mg vaginal <br> tablets | one vaginal tablet daily, at bedtime, for 6 days. | Can support a partial uplift in demand. |
